ALL alcoholics are well acquainted with the "Dutch courage" type of drinker, the guy who takes belt after belt because he thinks it gives him the nerve to do things he wouldn't do without a boost from old John Barleycorn. It rouses him to feats of great courage, he likes to believe. Well, that was me in my drinking days.

In 1947, I was invited by a boozing pal to a banquet given in honor of a famous military figure. Naturally we had to take on a large load beforehand to make sure we'd appreciate the significance of the occasion.

While we fueled up in the hotel bar, my friend told me about his son, who was away at military school and rather homesick.

"Would it help if I got him the autograph of a famous general?" I asked, my heart aflame with good will, patriotism, friendship and plain old *joie de vivre*.

"Sure would," he agreed.

THE PREVAILING AA SPIRIT

A well-known AA speaker, from the 1970s, replied to his wife who queried about his very first AA meeting: Well, he replied, they smoked a lot of cigarettes and they drank a lot of coffee; and I am going back! Of course, it wasn't the cigarette smoking or coffee drinking, or even the different personalities that prompted his decision—it was that invisible AA spirit that we all know so well! I recall when I was only a few months



sober and working at an antique store located only a few blocks from a recovery clubhouse at 26th and Broadway, in Santa Monica, California. The most exciting thing at that club was a checker-

board. Yet when the newcomer heebie-jeebies began their chaos and imagined torture, I would forgo lunch, and make a b-line for that club—nervously shaking and head spinning like a top! Yet, upon entry a mysterious calmness would take over. Soon a much-needed AA style conversation would erupt. Following

that brief experience. I would return to work-without eating a bite, mind you, refreshed and in a pleasant frame of mind.



We got there late, of course, with the festivities already under way, and found ourselves stuck behind a stout cordon of husky cops. Behind them we could catch a glitter of camera lights and a blazing sea of white shirtfronts.

I was inspired. My Dutch courage was roused to a high peak. I spoke brusquely to one of the policemen. "Lend me a pencil," I said in a tone that suggested this was an order, not a request.

After he meekly handed me a pencil, I brushed him aside, strode right up to the speakers' table and accosted the guest of honor. He listened patiently as I explained about the son of my friend who was homesick and how happy he'd be to get the signature of so great a man.

The guest grinned a famous grin and asked the lad's name. I told him.

A moment later I joined my stunned friend. "Here you are," I said, with studied casualness, handing him a scrap of paper. On it was scrawled: "To Jimmy: Stick with it. It isn't so bad.--Dwight D. Eisenhower."

I felt a rough hand grab me by the shoulder and my pal and I were steered to the nearest door. "If I'da known you was just another autograph hound," the cop said, breathing fire, "I'da. . .I'da. . .well, I wouldn'a loaned you that pencil!"
