Jail Visit I can tell my own story of how it was, and then the laugh's on me

SO THE GUY'S in this cell and there's soda-pop cans on the concrete floor. The bare John is over next to the wall. The guy's T-shirt is kinda crummy, but his hair is combed. He's nervous. He's calling me "sir," and I'm just in clean jeans and an open-necked shirt. The other caller with me--Bill-is sitting on the bed with the recovering drunk, and I'm squatting against the wall and my legs are getting cramped, so I slip to the floor and sit up against the wall.

This drunk's eyes show he's hurting, hurting bad, and I want to put my arm around him and tell him it's all right. But I don't. I know that's the last thing I want to show this guy openly. I've got to get it to him without him knowing it--that I care. I've got to

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Courage to Change Those obstacles in the way of our sobriety can be moved

IN THE EARLY years of my struggle, I was unable to maintain continuous sobriety. I became what is commonly known as a spree drinker. I would stay sober for six months or a year, and then go on a spree for as little as a week to as long as several months.

At the end of one such spree, I was fortunate enough to land in a mental hospital that had an excellent alcoholic rehabilitation program. After restoring the physical sell as much as possible, we began group therapy and other psychiatric sessions to restore the mental self.

I can still remember my inventory sessions with one of the psychologists. She would always ask, "What were you doing before you went on your last spree? I don't want to know what you did *after* you got drunk, but what you were doing, or not doing, that got you in such an emotional state that you wanted to commit suicide with a liquor bottle," she would say.

After a number of such sessions, I began to let my mind drift back to

Rebuilding on the Wasted Years

I'VE BEEN in prison many times and for many years since I was a teenager and was sentenced to five years for raping a girl. I didn't know I'd done it, because I was drunk. During that first prison term, I learned how to be a criminal.

When I got out, I tried being honest, but all I got was rejected, so I turned to drink again. Booze put me in another world--carefree, no worries. Soon I was in prison again for three years for rape and again another time for five years. I never learned a thing and only thought of getting out and getting drunk and making people pay.

Now I'm back for from four to six years. But this time I'm in a state hospital and I've been introduced to AA, and this has changed my outlook completely. It's a year since these wonderful people opened up this new world to me. They have helped me to look at myself and convinced me that I can do something about my life. I want help, and I'm getting it from AA.

I realize that I have to work hard with this program to make all the changes in myself. I feel I can reach out to help others, which I never dreamed of doing before. I try not to think of all the wasted years. I've only been in the program for one year, but it is the best year of my whole miserable life. There has been a lot of progress, and I don't want to lose what I have today--my sell -respect and friends. I pray for faith, for in this prison it can be hard at times and self-pity and mistrust can take hold of me. But I know that, with God in my corner, I can live a normal

life and I don't have to pick up that first drink.

Thinking of all those years in prison for rape hurts me inside every time I consider what I did, but I'm told I must forgive myself if I want to stay sober. One five-year sentence was for not reporting to my probation officer. I was carrying guns, knives, and whatnot, and the way I was hating people and myself, only God knows why I am alive today.

I would like Grapevine readers to know that someone inside a prison wants to help them, and maybe it would help them and me if we could correspond.

He may learn to lose it if he ever gets the program, but he needs his pride now to get him by, get him past this time when he's on the edge of going to pieces like a shorted dynamo spinning faster and faster and faster until everything flies out of it. all the soldering that's holding it together, and then the big pieces.

"Humility, after the first shock, is a cheerful virtue." So how can I get this guy to laugh at himself? I can't, but I can tell my own story of how it was at first, and then the laugh's on me. It's so funny to lose your mind. I look up at the ceiling and mention that I don't see any footprints. He gives a short--very short--laugh, saying there should be footprints up there.

We tell each other about our crazy driving. He remembers wondering how the staff of a road sign got into the cab of his pickup, right through his windshield and stuck into the metal alongside his head. He must have been


going kind of fast. Bill and I agree with him, but without sympathy, just mentioning that windshields are expensive to replace these days. We all three agree a thing like that can sure get into your drinking money.

The guy is wide-eyed and overflowing with gratitude, because we came in to see him. He wants to buy us a soda as we're leaving, but we say, "No thanks. We just had dinner." There's surprise on the guy's face. There's a light in his eyes that seems to have brought them a hit out of the depths of their sockets. Maybe that light is hope--hope that there's a way out after all.

the time before my most recent spree, and the one before that, and so on. Finally, I began to get the pattern of what was going on in my emotional makeup prior to my drunken sprees.

Before one of my sprees, I was working on a job that I hated. Each weekday morning, a miserable feeling would come over me. I could never get up on time, and I was always glad when the hour came to go home. Eventually, I got drunk and wouldn't go to work at all. The union had saved my job many times, but this time I was fired.

Some of my other sprees were preceded by intolerable love affairs and marriages that created inordinate friction in my day-to-day existence. Before still others, I allowed myself to become involved in situations, either social or business, that gave me negative selfimages or feelings of inferiority.

Now I've been sober for a number of years, because I've learned that I have to get my mind in shape when I seem to be heading for a drunk. I take an inventory and determine what in my everyday activities is causing me to feel emotional discomfort. Once I locate the source of my difficulty, I then must find the courage to change either the thing that creates my problem or my attitude toward the problem.

I said the Serenity Prayer many

times before I realized what it means by "courage to change the things I can." "Courage to change" means just what it says. We are victims of habit, fond of sameness; we don't like to rock the boat. On the other side of the scale, the alcoholic probably needs a positive self -image more than anyone, and he needs a life that is as free from tension and turmoil as possible. But it takes courage to face life and make the changes necessary for our peace of mind.

How many times we hear people say. "He or she wouldn't be that way if it wasn't for. . ."

I'm under no illusion that any of these things are easy, for I still struggle and find some peace sometimes just in small steps forward. But I am convinced that the obstacle to sobriety and peace of mind will move if we can find the "courage to change the things" we can.




