



process of skin, only to exit shiny happy ture of the gar-Oxymoronically. that my new perpetrated not what knowledge but what had gotten rid thereafter I bestrength and when a butterfly cocoon. I

emerged into the sunlight with an accompanying sense of joy and freedom. Some months later, that ever-present mental obsession was miraculously removed from my emotional vocabulary, and has not returned to date.

This was all some years ago, but AA growth continues like a tree; not only in height but also in roots, as well — if the roots do not grow in relationship to its height the tree will likely topple into the nearest watering hole. I believe this is why Steps 10, 11 and 12 are usually referred to as the **Growth** and Maintenance Steps. rather than simply "Maintenance Steps." These three daily Steps contain the essence of the nine previous ones — so, if I continue to live in the spirit of the AA program of action, those roots will grow proportionally. So long as I follow the Big Book directions, I believe I shall remain safe and secure from ever again taking that first drink.

# An Important 10<sup>th</sup> Step Promise

This is called a mental obsession. Hap-

And better yet we get to keep this wonderful release so long as we remain in a fit spiritual condition!

Yet, although this release may last for a lifetime, it exists only as a conditional state of being — a fully 'recovered' alcoholic could be drunk before next Thursday if he or she throws God and AA out the window. I must never forget to strive to remain in a fit spiritual condition. Dr. Bob ends his Bia Book story saying: "Your Heavenly Father will never let you down." He hasn't vet!




