

Step Twelve: "Having had a spiritual awakening as the result of these steps, we tried to carry this message to alcoholics, and to practice these principles in all our affairs."

Bill Wilson first got the idea of helping others find sobriety shortly after his spiritual experience at Towns Hospital about the 14th of December, 1934. He wrote of this idea occurring to him:



He immediately joined the Oxford Group where he learned the Five Cs: Confidence, Confession, Conviction, Conversion and Continuance; the latter of which stated: "... but part of the way I guarantee my own Continuance


